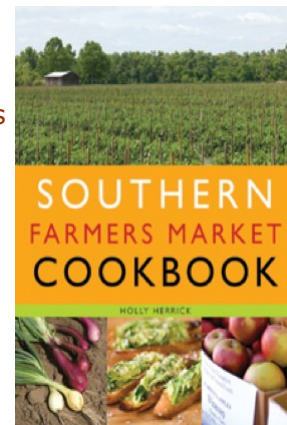


#### TRISTAN'S NEW LOUNGING SERIES
